There was a discussion about the expenses associated with the construction at the building on main street having to do with the spray on insulation of the roof. \$27,000 in expenses could be waived.

Basic approval of all business was met following the agenda (section I - call to order).

Highway Commission Muehlfelt has already used up 160 tons of salt (an average storm uses 70 tons). A car ran a stop sign and t-boned a snow plow, taking it out of commission.

A bankrupt subdivision is asking for a snowplow agreement but chose to "go to the newspapers." Mr. Muehlfelt said he isn't obligated to plow the street since it is a private street and doesn't intend to plow it.

There was some discussion about the selling of Nicor to an Atlanta based firm. Chair Heidorn's son-in-law works for Nicor, so he stated that as information becomes available, he will disseminate it. CUB is going to help explain to senior citizens how to save money on their utility costs.

Dental Insurance is renewed.

Pace contract is pending Naperville decision making.

New business: All Levys pass (Road district fund, Town and general assistance fund, special police fund, mosquito abatement fund (with an increase) - Robert Larsen has resigned to be seated on the county board. Maria Jensen is appointed to fill his vacated seat. She is sworn in and her first motion is to adjourn the meeting.
