Defend Democracy Issue: Funding for Illinois Public Schools

League of Women Voters IL Position:

The League of Women Voters believes that the government must provide an equitable, quality public education for all children from pre-K through grade 12. A quality public education is essential for a strong, viable, and sustainable democratic society and is a civil right.¹

Status:

- o In 2017 Illinois legislators passed a law to change the way public education is funded.
- Evidence-Based Funding for Student Success Act (EBF) put in place a formula to equitably distribute new state funds to school districts, taking into account differences in local resources, priorities and need.
- EBF has helped increase funding for K-12 schools while driving resources to the most underfunded districts.
- o In 2023 there were 1.3 million Illinois students in underfunded school districts.
- o Illinois needs an investment of \$550M in new state funds for EBF in the FY25 budget.
- LWVIL has partnered with Advance Illinois to lobby Governor Pritzker on this issue.
