
WORKFORCE COMPOSITION

Education was the largest industry sector in Glen Ellyn in 2020, accounting for roughly 4,475 jobs (41%)

This includes jobs in the local school districts and at the College of DuPage. Health Care, Accommodation and Food Service, Retail Trade, and Professional sectors each accounted for **5-10%** of jobs. The top employment sectors for Glen Ellyn residents were Professional Services, Health Care and Education Services, each of which accounted for more than **10%** of resident jobs.

The average annual wage of approximately **65%** of Glen Ellyn workers is less than **\$63,000**. Approximately **54%** of workers in Glen Ellyn earn less than \$3,333 per month, compared to **37%** of residents in Glen Ellyn.

WORKFORCE COMMUTING PATTERNS

Pre-pandemic, 8.5% of residents both lived and worked in Glen Ellyn

In 2020, **1,020** residents (**8.5**%) both lived and worked in Glen Ellyn. The remaining **91.5**% of residents commuted elsewhere to work. Similarly, a large share of employees who work in Glen Ellyn live elsewhere. The top residence locations of Glen Ellyn workers and top employment locations of Glen Ellyn residents are presented on the following page.

Census figures have not yet been released articulating how these trends have shifted as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.
